Arizona Foundation for Women (AFW), a local organization that supports essential programs that assist women through grant-funding, announced its new virtual awards event--a digital alternative to their annual luncheon event fundraiser. This event also celebrates the Foundation's 25<sup>th</sup> year of serving the Arizona community

The virtual awards event will feature the Foundation's award recipients, who were originally scheduled to make an appearance at the traditional luncheon that has been canceled due to COVID-19:

- Gretchen Carlson 2020 Sandra Day O'Connor Lifetime Achievement Award honoree for her advocacy for female empowerment, especially in the work place. Carlson, an award-winning journalist, was influential in the #MeToo movement with her historic 2016 sexual harassment complaint against the chairman of FOX News. Her struggles with harassment was recently retold in the movie, *Bombshell*, with actress Nicole Kidman playing her.
- <u>Christi Paul</u> 2020 Voice of Women Award honoree for her longtime involvement with causes that help children and teens. Paul founded Find Our Children, a partnership with the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children in Washington, D.C. She is the author *Love Isn't Supposed to Hurt*, published in 2012, about her journey in overcoming verbal and emotional abuse.
- <u>Barbara Strachan</u> 2020 Marilyn R. Seymann Award honoree for developing and building inclusive programs for Girl Scouts from all walks of life for more than 20 years. She was instrumental in co-creating the Adelante Jovencitas (Young Women Moving Forward) program which received the FBI Directors Community Leadership Award. She is the director of Social Impact Programs for Girl Scouts—Arizona Cactus-Pine Council.

Local celebrity and media personality, <u>Carey Peña</u>, hosts the virtual event, which will include an exclusive interview with Carlson, via video conferencing.
